



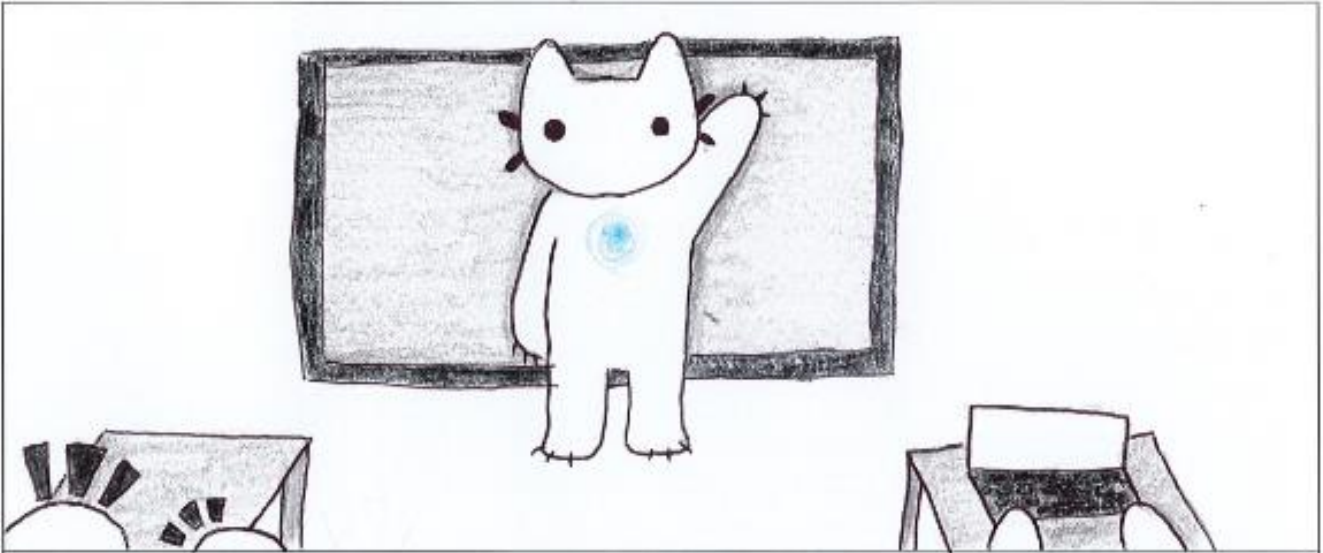

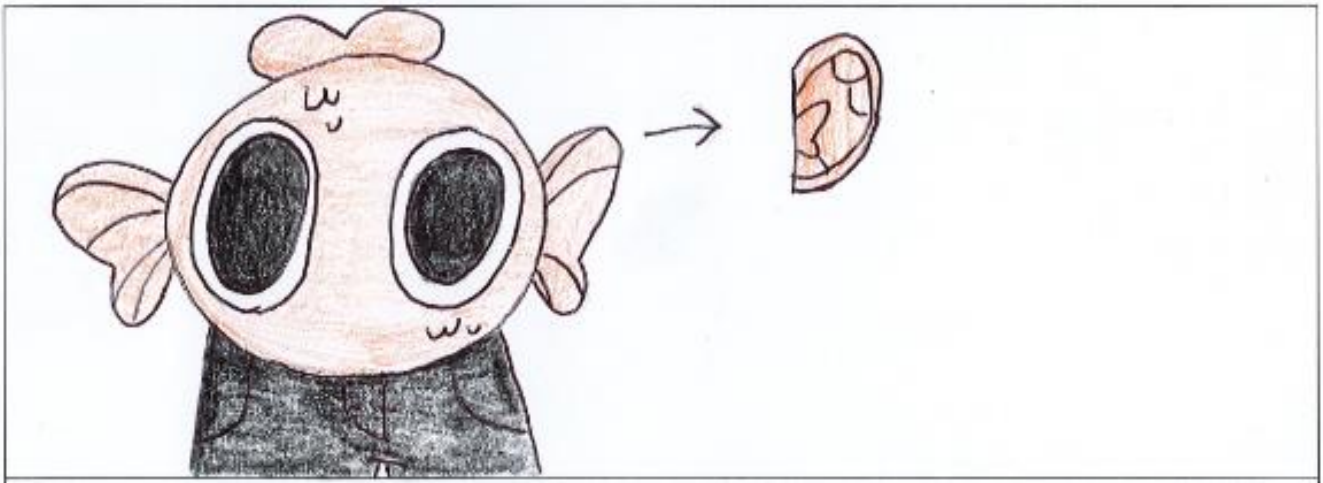
Storyboard Title: Respect by Alice

Frame 1:



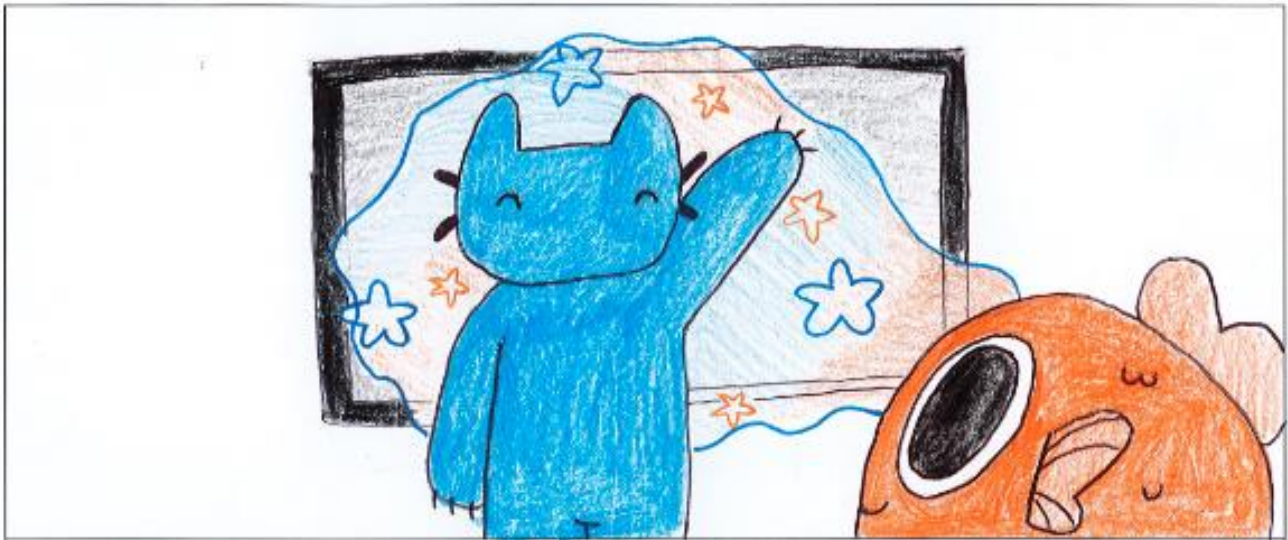
Description: Blue cat is presenting his work. When he looks around and notices no one in his class is listening to him, it upsets him.

Frame 2:



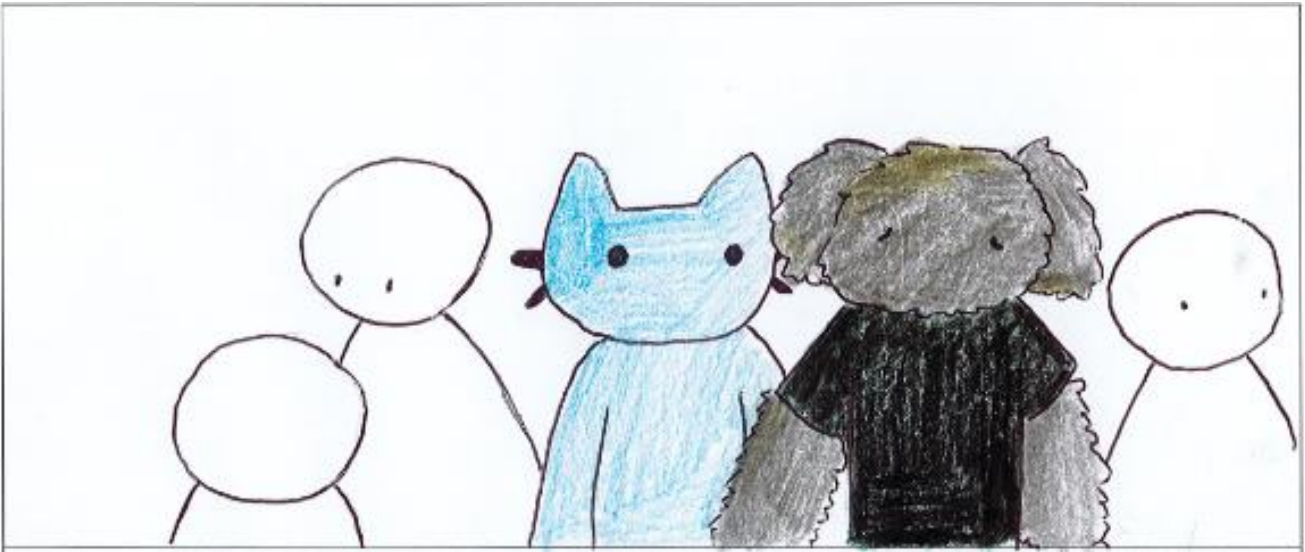
Description: Fish notices no one is listening to blue cat. Fish shows **respect** by looking at him and listening to his presentation.

Frame 3:



Description: Blue cat notices fish is listening and it makes him happy, he feels more passionate about showing his presentation now.

Frame 4:



Description: Next time blue cat is hanging out with his group of friends he notices nobody is listening to dog. Blue cat remembers how nice it felt to have somebody listening to you.

Frame 5:



Description: Blue cat shows respect by listening to dog, it makes dog happy and now he feels included.

Frame 6:



Description: Everyone deserves to be shown **respect!**

The story is in black and white but when respect is shown the characters involved get colourful and a coloured 'respect cloud' appears. The cloud is a mix of the two characters main colour but lighter. This shows how respect makes BOTH characters involved happy.
